

## ANNEX F

### AUTHORITY FOR THE INSTRUMENT

In Saskatchewan, the Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority (the Authority) has the power to adopt the proposed amendments, as the Authority regulation, pursuant to the following provisions of *The Securities Act, 1988* (Saskatchewan) (the Act):

Subclause 154(1) of the Act

(b) prescribing requirements respecting applications for registration and the amendment;

(u.5) prescribing information, documents, records or other materials that are required to be filed or delivered, including requirements relating to the following:

- (i) the method by which they are to be filed or delivered;
- (ii) the timing of the filing or delivery;
- (iii) the costs related to the filing or delivery;
- (iv) when they are deemed to have been filed, delivered or received;

(hh.1) (ii) respecting the media, format, preparation, form, content, execution, certification, dissemination and other use, filing and review of all documents required pursuant to or governed by this Act, and the regulations and all documents determined by the regulations to be ancillary to the documents;

(kk) varying the application of this Act to permit or require the use of an electronic or computer-based system for the filing, delivery or deposit of:

- (i) documents or information required pursuant to or governed by this Act or the regulations; and
- (ii) documents determined by the regulations to be ancillary to documents required pursuant to or governed by this Act or the regulations; and

(ll) establishing requirements for and procedures with respect to the use of an electronic or computer-based system for the filing, delivery or deposit of documents or information including requirements for paying charges or fees in connection with the use of the system

**Bill No. 65-** currently in the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan will amend subsection 154(1)(ll) above by adding “including requirements for paying charges or fees in connection with the use of the system” after “delivery or deposit of documents or information”.
