This is a notification to all licensed Saskatchewan mortgage brokers that as of June 18, 2010 Joseph Siganski, operating as Priority Mortgage, surrendered his licence to the Financial Institutions Division of the Saskatchewan Financial Services Commission. Therefore Joseph Siganski is no longer authorized to carry on business in Saskatchewan as a mortgage broker.

The Financial Institutions Division is conducting an investigation into Mr. Siganski's activities as a mortgage broker.


If you have had any dealings with Mr. Siganski as a mortgage broker after July 1, 2009, please advise us in writing by July 31, 2010.
