ORDER RE: REQUEST FOR ADJOURNMENT

WHEREAS pursuant to section 17 of *The Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan Act*, SS 2012, c F-13.5 (the "**FCAA Act**"), the Chairperson of the Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan (the "**Authority**") has appointed a panel (the "**Hearing Panel**") to hear this matter;

AND WHEREAS by virtue of subsection 17(7) of the *FCAA Act*, a decision or action of the Hearing Panel in relation to this matter is a decision of the Authority;

AND WHEREAS the merits component of the hearing for this matter was scheduled to proceed on February 10, 2025 and continue, if necessary, on February 11 and 12, 2025;

AND WHEREAS the Respondent, Ron Ochitwa, has requested an adjournment of the above hearing dates;

AND WHEREAS the Securities Division of the Authority neither consents to nor opposes the adjournment request;

AND UPON hearing submissions from legal counsel for the Securities Division of the Authority and legal counsel for the Respondent;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The requirement to send and file a Notice of Motion under *Saskatchewan Policy Statement 12-602 Procedure on Hearings and Reviews* in relation to the Respondent's adjournment request is waived;
2. The request to adjourn the hearing dates of February 10, 11, and 12, 2025 is granted;
3. The merits component of the hearing for this matter shall proceed on **April 14, 2025 at 9:00 am (CST)** and continue, if necessary, on **April 15 and 16, 2025** and any other such dates and times as may be determined by the Hearing Panel;
4. In accordance with subsection 9(15) of *The Securities Act, 1988*, SS 1988-89, c S-42.2, should any party fail to attend the hearing on the date(s) set forth above, the Hearing Panel may proceed with the hearing in the absence of the party and make or give any decision as though that party were present;
5. The hearing will be held by way of a virtual hearing unless otherwise ordered by the Hearing Panel; and

6. Any party may raise preliminary matters with the Hearing Panel for its consideration, including the party's availability on the established hearing dates above, by providing written notice of the matters or issues to be raised to the Registrar of the Authority as soon as possible.
