Notice of Application to Extend a Temporary Order

Take notice that a panel of the Saskatchewan Financial Services Commission (the Commission) will hear an application filed by Staff of the Commission via teleconference on Thursday, September 8, 2011 at 1:30 pm

Staff of the Commission will ask the Commission panel to consider whether it is in the public interest to order that the temporary order issued pursuant to section 134 of *The Securities Act*, 1988, SS 1988, c. S-42.2 (the Act) dated February 10, 2011(the Temporary Order) against you be extended until September 22, 2012 or for such period of time as the Commission considers necessary.

Staff of the Commission will seek an extension of the Temporary Order based on the following facts:

1. The Director of the Securities Division of the Commission issued the Temporary Order ordering, among other things, that the exemptions in Saskatchewan securities laws do not

apply to you and that you cease trading in all securities and exchange contracts up to and including February 10, 2011;

- 2. The Temporary Order was issued without notice to you because the length of time required to hold a hearing would be prejudicial to the public interest;
- 3. The Commission issued an Order on February 10, 2011 extending the Temporary Order to September 22, 2011;
- 4. It is necessary to extend the Temporary Order until September 22, 2012 to obtain further directions from the Hearing Panel in light of other issues around the file including involvement of other authorities in the activities of the Respondents. Further an extension of the Temporary Order to September 22, 2011 will provide ample time to prepare and file a Notice of Hearing, set a Hearing date and prepare documents/ witnesses for a hearing

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that you are entitled to be represented by legal counsel on the return date;

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that you may call witnesses and submit such evidence relevant to the application;

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the following documents are attached to this notice of application:

- 1. Affidavit in support of a Notice of Application for an Extending Order; and
- 2. Draft Extending Order

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that if you do not attend at the time and place as aforesaid, the hearing will proceed in your absence and the Commission may make or give any decision or order as though you were present.
