Local Matters

Authority for Amendments

The following provisions of *The Securities Act, 1988* (Saskatchewan) (the Act) provide the Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan (the Authority) with the authority to implement the amendments:

- Paragraph 154(1)(00) of the Act authorizes the Authority to make regulations exempting any person, company, trade or security from all or any provision of the Act or the regulations, including prescribing any terms or limitations on an exemption and requiring compliance with those terms or limitations;
- Paragraph 154(i)(k.1) of the Act authorizes the Authority to make regulations respecting any matter necessary or advisable for regulating credit rating organizations, including prescribing requirements with respect to a credit rating organization or a class of credit rating organizations designated pursuant to the Act.
