**Title**

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Securities Commission (Adoption of National Instruments) (NI 94-102) Amendment Regulations, 2022*.

**RRS c S-42.2 Reg 3 amended**

2 *The Securities Commission (Adoption of National Instruments) Regulations* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

**Appendix, Part LXII amended**

3(1) National Instrument 94-102 *Derivatives: Customer Clearing and Protection of Customer Collateral and Positions* in Part LXII of the Appendix is amended in the manner set forth in this section.

(2) Section 43 is repealed and the following substituted:

“Customer collateral report – regulatory

43. A regulated clearing agency that receives customer collateral must electronically deliver to the regulator or securities regulatory authority, within 10 business days of the end of each calendar quarter, a completed Form 94-102F3 *Customer Collateral Report: Regulated Clearing Agency*.”

(3) Form 94-102F3 *CUSTOMER COLLATERAL REPORT: REGULATED CLEARING AGENCY* is amended by repealing footnote 3 and substituting the following:


“<sup>3</sup> The Reporting Period is the calendar quarter for which the form is submitted.”.

**Coming into force**

4(1) Subject to subsection (2), these regulations come into force on July 26, 2022.

(2) If these regulations are filed with the Registrar of Regulations after July 26, 2022, these regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.
