Amendments to *The Securities Act, 1988* and *The Securities Regulations* come into force April 30, 2010

On April 30, 2010 the following sections of *The Securities Amendment Act, 2007* came into force:

- Subsection 3(19) of the amendment act that repeals subsections 2(7), (8) and (9) of *The Securities Act*, 1988 (the Act);
- That part of section 42 of the amendment act that repeals section 117 "Report of transfer by insider" of the Act.

Also on April 30, 2010 the following sections of *The Securities Regulations* (the Regulations) were repealed under *The Securities Amendment Regulations*, 2010:

- Section 164 to 166;
- Sections 169 and 170;
- Sections 172 and 173.

The repealed provisions of the Act and Regulations related to insider reporting. They became redundant with the coming into force of National Instrument 55-104 *Insider Reporting and Exemptions* on April 30, 2010.
