

Local Notice General Order 45-504 Offering Memorandum Prospectus Exemption

March 8, 2023

The Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan (FCAA) is implementing General Order 45-504 Offering Memorandum Prospectus Exemption (**GO 45-504**) effective March 8, 2023.

The Multilateral CSA Staff Notice 45-309 (Revised) Guidance for Preparing and Filing an Offering Memorandum under National Instrument 45-106 Prospectus Exemptions published today, March 8, 2023 provide guidance to issuers, underwriters and their advisors that intend to rely on the offering memorandum prospectus exemption in section 2.9 of National Instrument 45-106 Prospectus Exemptions (Revised CSA SN 45-309).

The guidance in Revised CSA SN 45-309 is also available to issuers distributing securities under GO 45-504.

GO 45-504 will expire on the earlier of the date on which GO 45-504 is revoked; or the date on which *The Securities Commission (Adoption of National Instruments)* (NI 45-106) Amendment Regulations, 2023 that addresses substantially the same subject matter as GO 45-504 come into force.
