CEASE TRADE AND REMOVAL OF EXEMPTION ORDER Section 134 and 135

WHEREAS an application has been received by the Saskatchewan Securities Commission (the "Commission") from the staff of the Commission for an Order pursuant to:

- 1. Subsection 134(1) of *The Securities Act, 1988*, S.S. 1988, c. S-42.2 (the "Act"), that Peter James Wilkins ("Wilkins") shall cease trading in all securities and commodity futures contracts in the Province of Saskatchewan or with any person resident in the Province of Saskatchewan, by any means including, through any company, limited partnership, association, joint venture or other entity of which he is or may be a director, officer, promoter or control person as defined by the Act, for a period of three years; and
- 2. Subsection 135(1) of the Act, that the exemptions contained in:
 - (a) Sections 38, 39, 81, 82 and 102 of the Act;
 - (b) *The Securities Regulations*, R.R.S., c.S-42.2 Reg 1 (the "Regulations") providing for exemptions from sections 27, 58, and 71 of the Act; and
 - (c) Any decision providing for exemptions from sections 27, 58, 71 or 104 to 109 of the Act;

do not apply to Wilkins for period of three years;

AND WHEREAS Wilkins and the Director of the Commission have entered into an Agreement and Undertaking dated November 20, 1995, the original of which is attached as Schedule "A" to this Order;

AND WHEREAS Wilkins has consented to the issuance of this Order and waived any right to a hearing in respect thereof;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this Order;

THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS:

- 1. Pursuant to subsection 134(1) of the Act, that Wilkins shall cease trading in all securities and commodity futures contracts in the Province of Saskatchewan, or with any person resident in the Province of Saskatchewan, by any means including, through any company, limited partnership, association, joint venture or other entity of which he is or may be a director, officer, promoter or control person as defined by the Act, for a period of three years from the date of this Order; and
- 2. Pursuant to subsection 135(1) of the Act, that the exemptions contained in:
 - (a) Section 38, 39, 81, 82 and 102 of the Act;
 - (b) The Regulations providing for exemptions from sections 27, 58 and 71 of the Act; and
 - (c) Any decision providing for exemptions from sections 27, 58, 71 or 104 to 109 of the Act;

do not apply to Wilkins for a period of three years from the date of this Order.
