4. Comparative interim financial statements for the interim period ending March 31, 2014, as required by Part 4 of National Instrument 51-102 - Continuous Disclosure Obligations.
5. Management's discussion and analysis materials for the interim period ending March 31, 2014, as required by Part 5 of National Instrument 51-102 - Continuous Disclosure Obligations.
6. interim certificates relating to the March 31, 2014 interim financial statements and management's discussion and analysis materials, signed by the chief executive officer and chief financial officer as required by National Instrument 52-109 – Certification of Disclosure In Issuer's Annual And Interim Filings.

(The "Required Records");

NOW THEREFORE it is ordered under Subsection 134.1(2) of the Act, that all trading in the securities of the Issuer cease until the Issuer files the Required Records.
