ORDER

WHEREAS on February 1, 2011, the Commission received oral representations from Alena Pastuch, Brian Pederson as agent for Idendego Inc. and advisor to Alena Pastuch, and Sonne Udemgba, as Securities Division legal counsel;

AND WHEREAS the Commission was advised that the Respondents still have not retained legal counsel;

AND WHEREAS the Respondents require disclosure so that they can prepare for the required hearing on the dates specified below, given that earlier attempts at disclosure through interim counsel did not result in the necessary disclosure;


NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The hearing into this matter shall commence on July 11, 2011 and continuing on July 12, 13, and 15, and thereafter until ordered otherwise.
2. The Respondents, with or without retained counsel, shall appear before the Commission in Regina, at a location to be determined, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon on July 11, 2011. Their failure to appear may result in the Commission receiving and hearing evidence in their absence, and rendering a decision based upon the evidence presented to it;
3. The Respondents shall be provided with proper disclosure as soon as practical, on such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between the parties. In the event that the parties are unable to agree upon the conditions to be attached to the disclosure, any conditions in dispute shall be

submitted in writing to the Secretary to the Commission for its consideration not later than February 14, 2011;

4. In the event that the Respondents are of the opinion that proper disclosure has not been provided to them, they are to raise their concerns by submitting them in writing to the Secretary to the Commission not later than March 11, 2011;
