REVOCATION ORDER (Subsection 158 (4))

WHEREAS the Director issued a cease trade order on April 12, 2005 pursuant to Subsection 134.1(2) of *The Securities Act, 1988*, S.S. 1988, c. S-42.2 (the "Act"), that trading in the securities of Bear Hills Pork Producers Ltd., Carrot River Valley Pork Producers Ltd., Horizon Pork Producers Ltd., and Manitou Hog Enterprises Ltd. (the "Issuers") shall cease until the Issuer files the Required Records;

AND WHEREAS the Issuers filed for creditor relief under the *Companies Creditors Arrangement Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, and as a result of this process, all of the undertaking, property, assets, and rights and interests of the Issuers were sold, with proceeds being used to pay secured creditors;

AND WHEREAS the unsecured creditors of the Issuers were paid the amount approved in the plan of arrangement by Order of the Court of Queen's Bench dated March 15, 2005, with a loan to the Issuers from the Saskatchewan Wheat Pool (now Viterra Inc.);

AND WHEREAS the Issuers have not carried on any business or undertaken any activity since mid 2005, have no assets, have substantial debts due to Viterra Inc., as well as substantial accumulated deficits:

AND WHEREAS Viterra Inc. wishes to effect a reorganization with the Issuers;

AND WHEREAS the Issuers have now filed alternate continuous disclosure records that are acceptable to the Director; to be provided to security holders of the Issuers as one component of information materials relating to the proposed reorganization;

THE DIRECTOR HEREBY ORDERS, pursuant to Subsection 158(4) of the Act, that the cease trade order dated April 12th, 2005 be and is hereby revoked against the Issuers effective the date of this order.
