CEASE TRADE ORDER (Subsection 134.1 (1))

WHEREAS 2020 IT Solutions Corp., (the "Issuer") being an issuer reporting by Order granted pursuant to the provisions of Section 83(1)(a) of *The Securities Act*, 1988, S.S. 1988, c. S-42.2 (the "Act"), has failed to file:

- 1. comparative annual audited financial statements and related filings fees for the fiscal periods ending January 31, 2010 and January 31, 2011, as required by Part 4.1 of National Instrument 51-102 *Continuous Disclosure Obligations*; and
- 2. comparative unaudited interim financial statements for the six months ending July 31, 2010 and July 31, 2011, as required by Part 4.3 of National Instrument 51-102 *Continuous Disclosure Obligations*.

(The "Required Records");

NOW THEREFORE it is ordered under Subsection 134.1(1) of the Act, that all trading in the securities of the Issuer cease until the Issuer files the Required Records.
