**VARIATION OF ORDER  
(SECTION 158(3))**

WHEREAS the Saskatchewan Securities Commission ("the Commission") issued an order on October 26, 1993 ("the Order") under *The Securities Act*, 1988, S.S. 1988, c. S-42.2 ("the Act"):

1. Pursuant to section 134 of the Act whereby it was ordered that Kenneth James Brittain ("Brittain") cease trading in any securities; and
2. Pursuant to section 135 of the Act whereby it was ordered that the exemptions contained in sections 38, 39, 81, 82 and 102 of the Act do not apply to Brittain.

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it would not be prejudicial to the public interest;

THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS pursuant to subsection 158(3) of the Act that the Order is varied by rescinding the order pursuant to section 134 of the Act that Brittain cease trading in securities;

THE COMMISSION HEREBY FURTHER CONFIRMS the part of the Order pursuant to section 135 of the Act which prohibits Brittain from using the exemptions contained in section 38, 39, 81, 82 and 102 of the Act.
