EXTENDING ORDER (Section 134)

**WHEREAS** the Saskatchewan Financial Services Commission (the "Commission") issued a Temporary Order dated July 31, 2006 (the "Temporary Order"):

- 1. pursuant to clause 134(1)(b) and (d) of *The Securities Act*, 1988, S.S. 1988, c. S-42.2 (the "Act") that Wellington Trading Group S.A. ("Wellington"), Eric Aquavia ("Aguavia"), Dan Davis ("Davis"), Al Moxey ("Moxey"), Ronnie Bethel ("Bethel"), Timothy Bell ("Bell") and Russell Finklestein also known as Russel Finkelstein ("Finkelstein"), (collectively the "Respondents") cease trading in all securities and exchange contracts up to an including August 14, 2006; and
- 2. pursuant to clause 134(1)(a) of the Act, that the exemptions contained in National Instrument 45-106 Prospectus and Registration Exemptions, and the exemptions contained in *The Securities Regulations*, R.R.S., c. S-42.2 Reg 1, shall not apply forthwith up to and including August 1, 2006, with respect to any trade in securities by the Respondents;

**AND WHEREAS** the Commission has delegated to the Director of the Securities Division (the "Director") the power to make orders pursuant to Section 134 of the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the Respondents have not requested a hearing pursuant to the terms of the Temporary Order;

**AND WHEREAS** the Director has not been provided with satisfactory information with respect to this matter;

**AND WHEREAS** the Director is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this Order;

**THE DIRECTOR HEREBY ORDERS** pursuant to subsection 134(3) of the Act that the Temporary Order be and is hereby extended until the Director is provided with satisfactory information to enable it to make a further order in this matter.
