

**IN THE MATTER OF

**ORDER
(Section 134)**

WHEREAS the staff of the Saskatchewan Securities Commission (the "Commission") has applied to the Commission for an order pursuant to:

1. Clause 134(1)(a) of *The Securities Act, 1988, S.S. 1988, c. S-42.2* (the "Act") that the exemptions contained in:

- a. sections 38, 39, 39.1, 81, 82 and 102 of the Act;
- b. *The Securities Regulations, R.R.S., c. S-42.2, Reg 1* (the "Regulations") providing for exemptions from sections 27, 58, 71 or 104 to 109; and
- c. any decision of the Commission providing for an exemption from any provision of the Act or Regulations;

do not apply to Martin Kreaus Williams Carpentier ("Carpentier") for a period of three years;

2. Clause 134(1)(d) of the Act that Carpentier cease trading in securities or exchange contracts in the Province of Saskatchewan for a period of three years;

AND WHEREAS Carpentier and the Director of the Commission have entered into an Agreement dated August 19, 1999, the original of which is attached as Schedule "A" to this Order;

AND WHEREAS Carpentier has consented to the issuance of this Order and has waived any right to a hearing;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this order;

THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS, pursuant to:

1. Clause 134(1)(a) of the Act that the exemptions contained in:
 - a. sections 38, 39, 39.1, 81, 82 and 102 of the Act;
 - b. the Regulations providing for exemptions from sections 27, 58, 71 or 104 to 109; and
 - c. any decision of the Commission providing for an exemption from any provision of the Act or Regulations;do not apply to Carpentier for a period of three years from the date of this Order;
2. Clause 134(1)(d) of the Act that Carpentier cease trading in securities or exchange contracts in the Province of Saskatchewan for a period of three years from the date of this Order, except as provided in paragraph three hereunder;
3. Carpentier may trade in securities in his own account through a registrant for the purposes of investing in his own registered retirement savings plan as defined in the *Income Tax Act* (Canada).
