REVOCATION ORDER

WHEREAS the Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan (**FCAA**) has assigned to the Executive Director of the Securities Division, FCAA (the **Director**) the power to make exemption orders under the provisions of *The Securities Act, 1988* (the **Act**) including orders of general application;

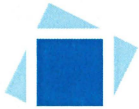
AND WHEREAS on May 1, 2019, the Director issued General Order 43-501 *Filing Fees for Shelf Prospectus Supplements including Pricing Supplements under National Instrument 44-102 Shelf Distributions*, (GO 43-501) pursuant to section 160 of the Act, exempting filers of shelf prospectus supplements for debt securities under National Instrument 44-102 *Shelf Distributions* (**NI 44-102**) from a portion of the filing fees under *The Securities Regulations, RRS c S-42.2 Reg 1* (the Fee Regulations), and exempting filers of pricing supplements for equity securities under NI 44-102 from all filing fees;

AND WHEREAS, GO 43-501 was effective retroactively as of December 1, 2018, and amended on August 30, 2019;

AND WHEREAS the staff of the FCAA have applied to the Director for an order pursuant to subsection 158(4) of the Act, revoking GO 43-501;

AND WHEREAS it has been represented to the Director that:

1. The fee amendments set out in *The Securities Amendment Regulations, 2025* (the **Fee Amendments**) will codify the exemptions introduced by GO 43-501 into the Fee Regulations;
2. The Fee Amendments will come into force on March 3, 2025; and



3. GO 43-501 is no longer required as a result of the Fee Amendments;

AND WHEREAS the Director is of the opinion that it would not be prejudicial to the public interest to revoke GO 43-501;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to subsection 158(4) of the Act, that GO 43-501 is revoked, effective March 3 2025.
