Order Setting Hearing Dates

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 17 of *The Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan Act* [FCAA Act], the Chairperson of the Authority has appointed a panel (the “Hearing Panel”) to hear this matter;

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of subsection 17(7) of the *FCAA Act*, a decision or action of the Hearing Panel in relation to this matter is a decision of the Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan (the “Authority”);

Upon hearing the submissions of legal counsel for Staff of the Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan (“Staff”) and Francois Paul Blouin concerning setting a date for a hearing into the above noted matter;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

3. Any party may raise preliminary matters with the Hearing Panel for its consideration, including said party's availability on the established hearing dates, by providing written notice of the matters or issues to be raised to the Registrar of the Authority as soon as possible.
