WHEREAS the Commission has received information with respect to Heritage Park Funeral Chapel Limited Partnership indicating that Heritage Funeral Services Inc. and in particular Vernon Graham Fraser have been trading in the securities of Heritage Park Funeral Chapel Limited Partnership, contrary to the provisions of Section 6 and 42 of The Securities Act;

AND THEREFORE, the Commission being of the opinion that it is in the public interest that trading should cease in respect to such securities and the Commission being of the opinion that the length of time required for a hearing could be prejudicial to the public interest;

THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS pursuant to Section 151 of The Securities Act that trading in the securities of Heritage Park Funeral Chapel Limited Partnership by Heritage Funeral Services Inc., and Vernon Graham Fraser shall cease forthwith for a period of 15 days

from the date hereof, but this order may be further extended for such period as the Commission considers necessary where sufficient information to enable the Commission to make an Order under Section 151 section (1) is not provided to the Commission within the 15 day period.
