CEASE TRADE ORDER


WHEREAS On the 11th day of January, 1983 a Temporary Order was issued that trading in securities by Canwest Financial Services Inc., A.C. MacKinnon and Bob Hall, with respect to Mayfair Court Apartments Limited Partnership, should cease forthwith for a period of 15 days from the date hereof, pursuant to Section 151 of The Securities Act;

AND WHEREAS satisfactory information was not provided to the Commission within the 15 day period stated in that Order;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is in the course of conducting an investigation with respect to the trading in securities by Canwest Financial Services Inc., A.C. MacKinnon and Bob Hall which the investigation is not complete;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission being of the opinion that it is in the public interest that trading in securities by Canwest Financial Services Inc., A.C. MacKinnon and Bob Hall should cease with respect to Mayfair Court Apartments Limited Partnership it is hereby ordered that the Temporary Order of August 4, 1982 be extended until such time as satisfactory information is provided to the Commission.
