## APPLICATION TO EXTEND A TEMPORARY ORDER

TAKE NOTICE that the Saskatchewan Financial Services Commission (the Commission) will hold a hearing at the 7<sup>th</sup> floor - 1919 Saskatchewan Drive, Regina, Saskatchewan on November 30, 2009 at 10 am:

TO CONSIDER WHETHER it is in the public interest to order that the temporary order of the Director of the Securities Division (the Director) issued pursuant to section 134 of *The Securities Act*, 1988 (the Act) and dated November 2, 2009 (the Temporary Order) against Alena Marie Pastuch (Pastuch), Teamworx Productions Ltd. (Teamworx), Idendego Inc. (Idendigo), 101114386 Saskatchewan Ltd. (4386) and 101115379 Saskatchewan Ltd. (5379) be extended until March 31, 2010 or for such period of time as the Commission considers necessary.

## BY REASON OF THE FOLLOWING MATTERS AND ALLEGATIONS:

- 1. The Director issued the Temporary Order ordering that the exemptions in Saskatchewan securities laws do not apply to Pastuch, Teamworx, Idendego, 4386 and 5379 (collectively the Respondents) up to and including November 16, 2009 and that the Respondents cease trading in all securities up to and including November 16, 2009;
- 2. The Temporary Order was issued without notice to the Respondents on the basis that the length of time to hold a hearing would be prejudicial to the public interest;

- 3. By letter dated November 5, 2009, legal counsel representing the Respondents requested a hearing to determine whether or not the Temporary Order should be continued;
- 4. On November 16, 2009 the Director, with the consent of legal counsel representing the Respondents, issued an order under section 134 of the Act extending the Temporary Order to December 15, 2009; and
- 5. Commission staff are gathering further evidence related to this matter.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that a person or company attending or submitting evidence at the hearing may be represented by legal counsel of its choice.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that any party to the proceedings may, at the hearing, call witnesses and submit such evidence relevant to the hearing as it may wish.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE THAT upon failure of the Respondents to attend at the time and place as aforesaid, the hearing may proceed in their absence and the Commission may make or give any decision or order as though that party were present.
