Extending Order (Section 134)

WHEREAS the Director of the Securities Division (the Director) of the Saskatchewan Financial Services Commission (the Commission) issued a temporary order dated November 17, 2009 (the Temporary Order) against the Respondents ordering that:

- Pursuant to subsection 134(3) and clause 134(1)(a) of the Act the exemptions in Saskatchewan securities laws do not apply to the Respondents, up to and including December 1, 2009;
- Pursuant to subsection 134(3) and clause 134(1)(d) of the Act the Respondents cease trading in all securities and exchange contracts up to and including December 1 2009; and
- Pursuant to subsection 134(3) and clause 134(1)(e) of the Act the Respondents cease giving advice respecting any securities, trades or exchange contracts up to and including December 1, 2009;

AND WHEREAS on December 1, 2009, the Commission issued an order extending the Temporary Order to April 1, 2010;

AND WHEREAS on March 25, 2010, the Commission issued an order further extending the Temporary Order to October 31 2010;

AND WHEREAS on October 21, 2010, the Commission further issued an order extending the Temporary Order to March 15, 2011;

AND WHEREAS on March 10, 2011, the Commission further issued an order extending the Temporary Order to September 23, 2011;

AND WHEREAS on May 25, 2011, the Commission scheduled the matter for hearing commencing on October 11 and continuing on October 12, 14, 17, 18 and 19, 2011;

AND WHEREAS staff of the Commission have applied for further extension of the Temporary Order until hearing is concluded;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this order;

THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS that:

- pursuant to subsection 134(3) of the Act that the Temporary Order be extended up to and including October 31, 2011 or until the Commission or the Director makes a further order in this matter;
- 2. reasonable attempts be made to serve the Respondents with a copy of this extending order; and
- 3. this extending order be posted for public notice in the normal course as a further means of notification to the Respondents
