NOTICE OF ADJOURNMENT OF HEARING AND TEMPORARY ORDERS

WHEREAS on July 6, 1990, a Deputy Director of the Saskatchewan Securities Commission gave notice of a hearing (the "Hearing") to be held on August 23, 1990 before the Saskatchewan Securities Commission (the "Commission") to determine whether the Commission will make orders against:

Mervin Derrick Constantine Holoboff, also known as Mervin Derrick Holoboff, also known as Derrick Mervin Constance Holoboff, Katheryn Elizabeth Louise McKinney, 328365 Alberta Ltd., CRS Industries Ltd. and Controll Roll Shutters Ltd. (the "Respondents");

pursuant to sections 134(1) and 135(1) of The Securities Act, 1988, S.S. 1988, c. S-42.2 (the "Act");

AND WHEREAS the Hearing set for August 23, 1990, was adjourned to December 11 and 12, 1990, at the request of counsel for the Respondents;

AND WHEREAS on December 6, 1990, counsel for the Respondents requested a further adjournment which was granted by the Commission;


AND WHEREAS on December 6, 1990, the Commission made temporary orders under sections 134, 135 and 159 of the Act against the Respondents and other persons and companies associated with the Respondents.

AND WHEREAS on January 29, 1991 counsel for the Respondents requested a further adjournment and counsel for the staff of the Commission has consented;

NOW THEREFORE the Commission, by consent, considering it necessary and in the public interest to do so, orders effective January 29, 1991:

1. That the Hearing be adjourned "sine die", provided that counsel may on five days notice to the Commission seek to fix a new date for the Hearing;
2. That the temporary orders issued by the Commission against the Respondents and others, dated December 6, 1990, be extended pursuant to section 159 of the Act until a hearing is held and a decision is rendered.
