**Order**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to section 17 of *The Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan Act* (the FCAA Act), the Chairperson of the Authority has appointed a panel (the Hearing Panel) to hear this matter;

**AND WHEREAS**, by virtue of subsection 17(7) of the FCAA Act, a decision or action of the Hearing Panel in relation to this matter is a decision of the Authority;

Upon hearing the submissions of legal counsel for Staff of the Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority of Saskatchewan (Staff of the Authority) and legal counsel for SHEC Energy Corporation and James Thomas Beck concerning setting a date for a hearing into a *Charter* application made by SHEC Energy Corporation and James Thomas Beck and a proposed motion relating to an abuse of process motion,


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. If SHEC Energy Corporation and James Thomas Beck intend to proceed with the proposed motion relating to an abuse of process motion, they must provide materials to Staff of the Authority and the Hearing Panel by no later than the end of the day on August 30, 2017;
2. Staff of the Authority will be permitted to respond to the materials referred to in paragraph 1, if received, by providing materials to SHEC Energy Corporation and James Thomas Beck and the Hearing Panel no later than the end of the day on September 5, 2017; and
3. A hearing will be held to consider the *Charter* application made by SHEC Energy Corporation and James Thomas Beck and the proposed motion relating to an abuse of process motion (if received in accordance with the above-noted timelines), commencing at 10:00 a.m. (CST) on September 14, 2017 and continue thereafter, if necessary, at 10:00

a.m. (CST) on September 15, 2017 or on such dates and times as may be determined by the Hearing Panel; and

4. This hearing will be held at the FCAA's Hearing Room, 7th Floor -1919 Saskatchewan Drive, Regina, Saskatchewan.
