Extending Order
(Section 134)

WHEREAS the Director of the Securities Division (the Director) of the Saskatchewan Financial Services Commission (the Commission) issued a temporary order dated February 15, 2011 (the Temporary Order) against the Respondents ordering that:

1. Pursuant to subsection 134(3) and clause 134(1)(a) of the Act the exemptions in Saskatchewan securities laws do not apply to the Respondents, up to and including February 10, 2011;
2. Pursuant to subsection 134(3) and clause 134(1)(d) of the Act the Respondents cease trading in all securities and exchange contracts up to and including February 10, 2011; and
3. Pursuant to subsection 134(3) and clause 134(1)(e) of the Act the Respondents cease giving advice respecting any securities, trades or exchange contracts up to and including February 10, 2011

AND WHEREAS on February 10, 2011, the Commission issued an order further extending the Temporary Order to September 22, 2011;

AND WHEREAS the Commission has not received a request from the Respondents for a hearing pursuant to the terms of the Temporary Order;


AND WHEREAS staff of the Commission have applied for further extension of the Temporary Order to September 22, 2012;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this order;

THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. pursuant to subsection 134(3) of the Act that the Temporary Order be extended up to and including September 22, 2012 or until the Commission or the Director makes a further order in this matter;
2. Commission staff make reasonable attempts to serve the Respondents with a copy of this extending order;
3. this extending order be posted for public notice in the normal course to continue to alert investors and as a further means of notification to the Respondents
