TEMPORARY ORDER
(Sections 134 and 135)

WHEREAS it has been represented to the Saskatchewan Securities Commission (the "Commission") by the staff of the Commission that:

1. George Frederick Garzarek ("Garzarek"), Timothy McLendon ("McLendon"), Trudy Krasnoff ("Krasnoff"), Louella Toews ("Toews") and Komax International Inc. ("Komax") have been engaging in the trading of securities in the Province of Saskatchewan within the meaning of The Securities Act, 1988, S.S. 1988, c. S-42.2 (the "Act");
2. Garzarek, McLendon, Krasnoff, Toews and Komax are not registered within the meaning of the Act;
3. No prospectus receipt has been granted to Komax pursuant to section 58 of the Act and no exemption Order has been issued;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this Order;

THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS, pursuant to:

1. Subsection 134(1) of the Act, that trading in all securities or commodity futures contracts in the Province of Saskatchewan or with any person resident in the Province of Saskatchewan by Garzarek, McLendon, Krasnoff and Toews shall cease forthwith up to and including November 15, 1993 and that all trading in the securities of Komax in the Province of Saskatchewan or by any person resident in the Province of Saskatchewan shall cease forthwith up to and including November 15, 1993;
2. Subsection 135(1) of the Act that the exemptions contained in:
 - a. Sections 38, 39, 81, 82 and 102 of the Act;
 - b. The Regulations providing for exemptions from sections 27, 58 and 71 of the Act; and
 - c. Any decision providing for exemptions from sections 27, 58, 71 or 104 to 109 of the Act;

do not apply forthwith up to and including November 15, 1993 with respect to any trade in securities and commodities futures contracts by Garzarek, McLendon, Krasnoff and Toews or to any trade of securities of Komax.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT:

1. This Order may be extended for such period as the Commission considers necessary where sufficient information to enable the Commission to make an order pursuant to subsection 134(1) is not provided to the Commission on or before the 15th day of November, 1993;
2. The Commission will, at the request of any person or company named in this Order, grant a hearing before the Commission with respect to the within matter, such hearing to be held at such time and place as the Commission shall determine;
3. The purpose of such hearing will be to consider whether it is in the public interest that a permanent cease trade order pursuant to subsection 134(1) of the Act and a permanent prohibition of statutory exemptions pursuant to subsection 135(1) of the Act be made with respect to Garzarek, McLendon, Krasnoff, Toews and Komax by reason of the breaches of the Act hereinbefore described and by reason of failing to provide the Commission with satisfactory information on or before the date of the hearing or any extension thereof by the Commission;
4. Any party to these proceedings may be represented by counsel of their choice at any such hearing before the Commission;
5. Upon failure of any party to attend any such hearing at the time and place set therefore, the hearing

may proceed in the absence of such party and such party is not entitled to any further notice of the proceedings therein.
