EXTENDING ORDER
(Section 151(2))

WHEREAS the Saskatchewan Securities Commission (the "Commission") issued a Temporary Cease Trade Order on March 17, 1988 (the "Temporary Order") pursuant to section 151(2) of The Securities Act, R.S.S. 1978, c. S-42 (the "Act") that trading in the securities of Horizon Robotics Systems (Canada) Inc. and Universal Robotics Corporation (the "Issuers") cease up to and including March 31, 1988;


AND WHEREAS the Commission has received a request from Universal Robotics Corporation for a hearing pursuant to the terms of the Temporary Order and which hearing will be set for April 27, 1988;

AND WHEREAS the Commission has not received a request from Horizon Robotics Systems (Canada) Inc. for a hearing pursuant to the terms of the Temporary Order;

AND WHEREAS the Commission has not been provided with sufficient information to enable it to make an order under section 151(1) of the Act with respect to either of the Issuers;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to section 151(2) of the Act that the Temporary Order be and is hereby extended until the Commission is provided with sufficient information to enable it to make an order under section 151(1) of the Act or until further ordered.
